Background Tarlac State University (TSU) generates several types of hazardous waste from its laboratories, maintenance, and other operational areas. To ensure compliance with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources - Environmental Management Bureau (DENR-EMB), TSU requires the services of a DENR-accredited third-party provider to manage the safe hauling and transport of hazardous. 2. Objective To engage a licensed service provider for the safe, legal, and environmentally sound hauling of hazardous waste. To ensure the proper transport and disposal of TSU's hazardous waste in accordance with DAO 2013-22, RA 6969, and RA 9003. 3. Scope of Work The service provider shall: Provide safe collection, loading, transport, and delivery of hazardous waste from designated TSU campuses and facilities. Ensure safe handling and compliance with labeling, segregation, and documentation requirements. Transport the waste to a DENR-accredited TSD facility. Coordinate closely with TSU's Pollution Control and Safety Unit (PCSU) during pre- and post-hauling activities. 4. Methodology The service provider must: Haul waste using licensed vehicles and trained personnel Deliver hazardous waste to a registered TSD facility. Submit the following post-hauling documentation: Signed Waste Manifest Certificate of Treatment and/or Disposal (COT/COD) 6. Deliverables The selected provider shall submit: Waste Manifest Forms Certificate of Treatment/Disposal (COT/COD) 7. Timeline and Frequency of Service Service Frequency: Semi-Annually (twice a year) 1st Cycle: July 2nd Cycle: January Service Duration: 1 working day per hauling event Specific date for hauling shall be coordinated with TSU-PCSU once the approved Permit to Transport has been acquired. The work order shall remain valid for a period of 60 calendar days from the date of issuance. Upon approval, please ensure that the Pollution Control and Safety Unit (PCSU) is duly notified. **The approved Permit to Transport shall be secured from the DENR-EMB, subject to the availability of all required documents and any additional requirements they may impose. 8. Cost and Payment Terms The quotation to be included in the Job Order Request for Hauling shall provide itemized costs per kilogram/hazardous waste number and hazardous waste report. 9. Quality Assurance and Control Measures Provider must be DENR-accredited for hazardous waste transport and in partnership with a licensed TSD facility. All collection and transport activities must comply with: DAO 2013-22 (Hazardous Waste Management) RA 6969 (Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Waste Control Act) RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act)
